Dear Parents,

You should have already received "Recital Information Packet #1" and "Important Recital Information." If not, please see the front desk immediately. All Picture Day information is included in Packet #1.

May 20 - Picture Day @ The Studio Your times are listed in Packet #1. Be sure to arrive 15 minutes early, fill out a picture order form and turn in your video, flower and/or dinner order forms.

Your times are listed in this packet. Do **NOT** wear your costume. Wear your Recital T-Shirt or play clothes & tennis shoes.

Information for the recital is in this Packet, please read carefully.

Dancer Seating: Dancer Seating Area opens at 6:00pm. All dancers must be in their seats at 6:15pm, the show begins at **6:30pm**. Only dancers and helping moms are allowed inside the Dancer Seating Area.

The Fruit Yard Amphitheater Seating: Seating is on the grassy hill. Handicap seating will be marked on the cement. The trees haven't grown yet so you may need sunscreen or a hat. NO pop-up tents, tall chairs or signs will be allowed. You may bring low back lawn chairs or picnic blankets to sit on.

Tickets: Tickets go on sale on Monday, May 8. You may purchase as many tickets as you wish. Helping Parents and Dancers DO NOT need a ticket. Tickets are \$10 for ages 13 and older, \$5 for children ages 3 – 12, and Free for children 2 years old and under.

Helping Moms: Most of our helping mom opportunities have been filled, however, if you are interested in helping see Tina at the front desk. Helping Moms do NOT need a ticket. You will receive a packet of important information that you will need to read and a T-shirt at the helping mom meeting on Saturday May 20 @ 1:00pm. Your T-shirt will allow you entrance into the amphitheater as well as the Dancer Seating Area.

Parking: You will not have to search for a parking space. You will need to park in the Concert Parking **ONLY**. There will be a parking fee of \$10 and attendants will park you on the premises and secure the lots during the show. You may **NOT** park on the Highway, in the restaurant parking lot or church parking lot - you will be towed. Parking spaces are close and easy.

Main Gates: Gates will open at 5:00pm so that you may enjoy dinner with your dancer. **Please do not eat in costume.**

Dinner: Preorders due May 25th. The Juline Regional Youth Ballet will be pre-selling \$15 dinners (prepared by The Fruit Yard) to enjoy at the show: Tri Tip Sandwiches, Chicken Salad, or Garden Salad with all the fixin's! All proceeds go to JRYB. You will pick up your dinner at the Recital and enjoy it before or during the show. There will also be a beverage tent for the purchase of adult beverages, soft drinks, and water.

You may NOT bring outside food into the amphitheater. However, if you choose to have your own picnic before the show, you may do so in the adjacent park next to the pond.

Flowers: Preorders due May 25th. It is a ballet tradition to present your dancer with flowers after a performance. The Juline Regional Youth Ballet will be selling flowers at the recital for your dancer.

Video: Orders due June 3rd. The recital will be professionally filmed, and flash drives will be available for pickup on June 12th.

Pictures: Pictures will be available for pickup at the Recital.

Creative Dancers: These dancers are our youngest. You will enter through your assigned gate (West Gate #C) and wait with your dancer until they go on stage. You will be able to watch their dance and then take them as soon as they finish. It is our hope that you will remain in the audience so your child can watch the other dancers. They love to watch the show!

Pre-Ballet 1: Our famous Quack Quack dancers will come to the Dancer Seating Area at 6:00pm (no earlier) and sit with their class. We will return them to their assigned seat after they perform. You may pick them up during **intermission** at the same gate where you dropped them off. They will want to stay and watch the remainder of the performance. The second half of the show is really fun!

Release of dancers: All other dancers will remain with us in the Dancer Seating Area until after the recital is over. Instructions for pick up will be announced from the stage and in your classroom during costume pick up.

Why a Park Setting for the Recital? We have enjoyed outdoor recitals for 49 years! It doesn't require hours of theatre rehearsal for lights and tech, it lowers your total cost for recital, it's a relaxed, non-intimidating atmosphere for your dancer and it's a lot of family fun!

Costume Handout: May 8 – 13

Girls in ballet - You will receive a tutu, headpiece, and tights. For those doing a tap dance you will also receive a poodle skirt. You will need clean “real” leather ballet shoes, no strings and tap shoes with tap ties. You may tie and cut your ballet shoestrings if needed.

Boys in ballet – You will wear your provided cummerbund. You will need your regular class black tights, black ballet shoes with no strings and white socks.

Girls and Boys in Jazz, Tap, Modern, Hip Hop - You will receive a costume top (shirt). You will also need to wear your jazz pants, appropriate shoes and hair pulled back off your face in a ponytail or bun.
